2.2.2 Change to The stewards for this event will be Bill Westrick (operations steward), Lyn Nelson (safety steward) and Joe Andreini (event steward).

6.3 Delete this. We were unable to obtain a current fuel order form.

7.6 There will be a video of the stages (competition miles only) available at the Rally America Store. There are only enough copies for the teams that have entered the rally so please show your route book to purchase a copy. The charge for the video is \$50. This is a sanction exception as per RA rule 7.1.B.

7.4. add The safety check at the shakedown stage will be performed by Mike Hurst. All safety equipment must meet Rally America Rules and determination of vehicle safety and integrity will be done by Mike. Remember You must still take your car through scrutineering and register your team at event registration in Bemidji to be eligible to start the event. Participating in the shakedown stage will prevent you from receiving any refund of your entry fee.

8.5a We will accept valid NASA competitor licenses from regional competitors. This is a sanction exception as per RA rule 2.1.A.3

11.1 Please change start intervals will be RA rule 1.7.E.5. We will reseed again on Saturday morning. To “RA rule 1.7.E.4”

11.5 Please note this sanction exception should have been underlined as: Any competitor who is unable to complete the super special shall be scored at the slowest completed time plus 1 minute. Failure to finish the super special will not be considered failure to complete a stage as per 7.7.C.2 in the 2009 Rally America Rules (sanction exception).

12.8 Please delete the sentence “There will be no service radio at the 5 minute fuel stops.”

11.5.1 There may be an electronic timer visible at the Bemidji Speedway stage. This timer is for announcer purposes only and is not to be considered the official time for the speedway stage.
